Short Synopsis:

Travis begins seeing unique messages inside fortune cookies. The fortunes help Travis at first, but all is not what it seems. The fortunes soon turn menacing. Now, Travis must do as the fortunes ask, or risk the consequences.

Treatment:

Travis sits alone in a Chinese food restaurant. He finishes his meal and reaches for a fortune cookie. To his surprise it does not contain the typical ambiguous fortune, but instead it tells him a scandalous secret about the girls sitting at the next table. Travis soon discovers that this secret is true and abruptly requests another fortune cookie. Only this time, the fortune isn't so friendly; it tells him that his mother is having a heart attack. Travis rushes home to save his mother, arriving just in time. Realizing the power of these fortune cookies he procures large quantities of them. The fortunes help turn Travis's life around, from a poor, goofy, lonely nerd to a rich, confident, sophisticate. But all is not what it seems. When he meets Rebecca, who is also being spoken to by the fortune cookies, things quickly turn sour. The cookie tries to pit both of them against each other. A stand off ensues and Rebecca has a gun pointed at Travis. About to pull the trigger, a knock at the door snaps Rebecca out of her murderous daze. At the door is Paul, Travis's police officer brother. Rebecca is forced to flee and Travis is left to explain his bizarre predicament to the ever-skeptical Paul. Realizing Paul will never believe him, Travis races off to try and save Rebecca from the evil cookie. The cookie leads Travis and Rebecca to a secluded spot in the woods. Unaware of their impending doom, the pair meets another other cookie victim. Off in the distance is a sniper, who is willing to carry out the cookies' grisly desires.
